TOUR ITINERARY:

Day 1 Houston / Frankfurt

Depart Houston on Lufthansa nonstop flight to Frankfurt.

Day 2: Frankfurt / Tel Aviv

Arrive in Frankfurt and change planes. In Tel Aviv you will be met by your guide and drive to the Galilee for dinner and overnight. **Overnight in Tiberias. D**

Day 3 Cana / Nazareth

Theme: The Annunciation

Start the day with a visit to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle at the request of His mother. There visit the Franciscan chapel where those who wish to participate may renew their wedding vows. Drive to Nazareth, the site of Mary's home and the town where Jesus lived as a child. At Nazareth, see the fascinating excavations there, celebrate Mass in the Basilica of the Annunciation, and visit the Byzantine Church of St. Joseph. This afternoon we return to the beautiful Mount of Beatitudes with time for reflection. **Overnight in Tiberias B, L, D**

Day 4 Tiberias / Sea of Galilee Theme: The Ministry of Christ in the Galilee

The day starts at the Mount of Beatitudes, scene of Jesus' great Sermon on the Mount, where we will have Mass. Then to Tabgha where Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000 and onto the site known as "Peter's Primacy." Here, after His resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter to "feed my lambs; feed my sheep." A short drive away is Capernaum, from where Jesus launched his Ministry; see the synagogue which dates to the time of Jesus and the church built over the site of Peter's home. Time for reflection. **Overnight in Tiberias B, L, D**

Day 5 Mt. Tabor / Bethlehem / Qumran Theme: The Transfiguration

Today, after breakfast, visit Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration for Mass and reflection Christ's Humanity

and Divinity. After lunch drive down the Jordan Valley to Jericho, the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world, where we view the Mount of Temptation and the Sycamore Tree. Travel to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Drive through the Judean Wilderness where Jesus spent 40 days fasting. We then continue to Bethlehem to check in to your hotel and meet for reflection. **Overnight in Bethlehem, B, L, D**

Day 6 Bethlehem Theme: The Nativity

Start the day with a visit to the Shepherds' Fields. The caves have soot marks of the fires that shepherds lit to keep warm while watching over their flocks. Drive to visit Bethlehem University for a chance to see the campus of this Catholic center of hope, which is supported by the Order. Lunch will be prepared by the students of the catering school and a student or two will join each table. You will gain a unique insight into daily life in present day Bethlehem and hear from young students. Then we visit Manger Square which stands in front of one of the oldest of Christian churches, the Church of the Nativity. Enter the Church and down to the Grotto of the Nativity which marks the spot of Jesus' birth. Beneath the Altar, there is a silver star with the Latin inscription: HIC DE VIRGINE MARIA JESUS CHRISTUS NATUS (Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary.) We will have Mass there and reflection. **Overnight** in Bethlehem. B, L, D

Day 7 Old City Temple Area / Bethany Theme: Early Years in Jerusalem and the Wilderness

Visit the Old City of Jerusalem to see the Western Wall Temple Area. At the steps of the Southern Wall of the Temple Mount ponder the Presentation of Jesus at the Temple, the finding of Jesus at the Temple and the healing of the blind man at the Temple. End the day with a visit to Bethany where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Celebrate Mass at Bethany and have time for reflection together. **Overnight in Jerusalem B, L, D**

Day 8 Jerusalem: Our Lady of Palestine / Emmaus

Theme: The Patronage of Our Lady

Visit the shrine of Our Lady of Palestine and have Mass to honor the patron of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. Visit the Jerusalem Museum for the history of the holy city. Time for reflection. **Overnight in Jerusalem. B, L, D**

Day 9 Jerusalem: Mt. Zion / The Upper Room Theme: The Last Supper

From here take the route through the Kidron Valley along which Jesus was taken as a prisoner to the house of the High Priest Caiaphas where He was interrogated and imprisoned. Now called Peter in Gallicantu ("crowing rooster"), this beautiful Church also commemorates Peter's Denial of Christ, his repentance and then being forgiven by Jesus. Visit Mount Zion and the Upper Room, commemorating the Last Supper with Mass at the Cenacle. Nearby is the Benedictine Church of the Dormition. Time for reflection. **Overnight in Jerusalem. B, L, D**

Day 10 Jerusalem: Mt. Of Olives / Gethsemane Theme: Palm Sunday and the Agony in the Garden

From the Mount of Olives take in the panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Pater Noster shrine, where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer (Luke 11:1-4). Walking down the Palm Sunday Road, stop at the beautiful little church, Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem [Luke 19:41]. At Gethsemane, reflect on Jesus' final night. The Garden contains olive trees with roots dating to the time of Jesus. Have Mass at the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock reverenced as where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Return to the hotel for reflection together. **Overnight in Jerusalem. B, L, D**

Day 11 Jerusalem: Via Dolorosa / Church of the Holy Sepulchre

Theme: The Way of the Cross and the Resurrection This marning we start the Via Polorosa (The Way of the Way of

This morning we start the Via Dolorosa (The Way of the Cross) at the Antonia Fortress, where Jesus was condemned to death by Pontius Pilate. From there He was taken through the city to be crucified. The Stations of the Cross lead through the markets of the Old City to the Church of





the Holy Sepulchre. Here is the site of Calvary and the Tomb of Christ. We will celebrate Solemn High Mass in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Later, visit the Latin Patriarchate for an audience with the prelate and for the Pilgrim Shell Ceremony. Time for reflection. **Overnight in Jerusalem. B**, **L**, **D**

Day 12 Departure

Transfer to airport for the flight home.
