13 DAY TRAVEL ITINERARY

**DAY 01 – March 8 Monday HOUSTON / PARIS**

Depart from Houston to Paris.

**DAY 02 – March 9 Tuesday PARIS**

Upon arrival in Paris, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 03 – March 10 Wednesday PARIS**

Today's sightseeing of Paris includes the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal, where Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Labouré. You will view the incorrupt remains of St. Catherine and St. Louise de Marillac. We will visit the Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul and see his incorrupt body. Continue sightseeing with Notre Dame Cathedral. Visit the Sainte Chapelle (Holy Chapel), a gothic marvel that was built by King St. Louis to house the Crown of Thorns, which was redeemed from the Venetians in the year 1239, and now resides in Notre Dame with other relics from Calvary. In the stone lacework of the chapel are set the most ancient stained-glass windows in Paris, depicting 1,130 scenes from the Bible. Stop and visit the La Madeleine, a basilica dedicated to St. Mary Magdalene. Dinner and overnight in Paris. BD

**DAY 04 – March 11 Thursday CHARTRES**

Board your bus and travel to Chartres, famed for its massive Cathedral Notre Dame. Visit both the magnificent 13th-century Gothic Cathedral, renowned for its soaring towers and stunning glass windows. It is the second-oldest structure to the Blessed Virgin and contains the veil of the Annunciation, sent to Charlemagne in 792 B.C. by the emperor of the Byzantine Empire. Return to Paris for dinner and overnight. BLD

**DAY 05 – March 12 Friday PARIS**

After breakfast, tour Sacre Coeur, the Basilica in Montmartre dedicated to the Sacred Heart. Have a tour of the first floor of the Eiffel Tower, see the Arch de Triumph and the Champs Elysees. **Attend the Veneration of the Crown of Thorns** at the Notre Dame Cathedral before heading back to your hotel in Paris for dinner and overnight. BD

**DAY 06 – March 13 Saturday PARIS / TEL AVIV / TIBERIAS**

This morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival, you will be met by your tour guide and driver, and we will travel to Tiberias, dinner and overnight in Magdala.

**Day 07 – March 14 Sunday TIBERIAS / BOAT RIDE ON THE SEA OF GALILEE / CAPERNAUM / MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / MOUNT TABOR**

Some of today's highlights are a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee, Capernaum to see the synagogue and St. Peter's house, the Mount of the Beatitudes, where the Sermon on the Mount was given, and have Mass. On to Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic of the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy, where Peter was told, "Feed my lambs, feed my sheep." In the afternoon, continue to Mount Tabor: scene of the Transfiguration. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

**DAY 08 – March 15 Monday CANA / NAZARETH / EITHER CAESAREA OR HAIFA / BETHLEHEM**

We start the day with a visit to Cana, the village of Jesus' first miracle of changing water into wine; here, couples may renew their wedding vows. Continue to the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth; visit the Church of St. Joseph where the Holy Family lived. If time allows, we may visit Stella Maris or Caesarea where the Romans held Paul prisoner, then continue to Bethlehem. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

**DAY 09 – March 16 Tuesday EIN KAREM / BETHLEHEM / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY / CHURCH OF VISITATION / BETHLEHEM UNIVERSITY / SHEPHERD'S FIELDS**

We head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and the Church of the Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth and proclaimed the "Magnificat." Continue to Bethlehem to visit Bethlehem University, the only Catholic University in the Holy Land, which is supported by the Order. In the afternoon, we drive to the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Then we visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, which stands upon the site where Jesus was born, and celebrate Mass Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Bethlehem.

**DAY 10 – March 17 Wednesday**  
**THE WILDERNESS: BETHANY / JERICHO /**  
**MT. TEMPTATION / DEAD SEA**

Drive to Bethany and see the Church of Lazarus, where we will have Mass. Further east, just off the Roman road that Jesus walked, is Wadi Qelt Gorge, the site of the Monastery of St. George. At the oasis town of Jericho, visit the excavations of the oldest city in the world and view Mt. Temptation, where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. On the way back, there is time for a swim (or rather a float!) in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. In the afternoon, there may be time for last-minute buying of gifts for your loved ones. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Bethlehem.

**DAY 11 – March 18 Thursday THE PASSION OF**  
**JESUS: MOUNT OF OLIVES / GETHSEMANE /**  
**PATER NOSTER / MEETING WITH THE LATIN**  
**PATRIARCH**

We begin our day on the Mt. of Olives to walk the Palm Sunday route, stopping at Dominus Fleuit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Drive to Gethsemane, which houses the Rock of Agony - where Jesus prayed His last prayer before his arrest - to have Mass. Visit the cave of betrayal, then the cave of the Assumption of Mary to heaven. Back on the Mt. of Olives, we visit the Pater Noster with the Lord's Prayer in many languages. We will return to Old Jerusalem to visit the Latin Patriarchate for the Pilgrim Shell Ceremony. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

**CROSS / CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE /**  
**ST. ANNES / WAILING WALL / UPPER ROOM /**  
**ST. PETER IN GALLICANTU**

We begin to retrace the last steps of Jesus as we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow) through the markets of the Old City, praying the Stations of the Cross, and reflecting on the greatness of His sacrifice. Celebrate Solemn High Mass at the Holy Tomb. Visit St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary and her parents, Saints Joachim and Anne. We finish the day at the Shrine of Our Lady of Palestine, the Patroness of the Order. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## The Tour Price Includes:

**Air Transportation:** Airfare is based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and include certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once tickets are issued, they are **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL**. Please refer to our CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY below. Airfare and tour prices are based on prices effective as of **JANUARY 1, 2027** and are subject to change without notice.

**Surface/Land Transportation:** All surface/land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by modern motor coach, designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred upon arrival and departure.

**Hotels:** We only use first-class hotels. Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 per room). We reserve the right to substitute hotels of similar quality for those specified in the itinerary.

**Single Room Supplements:** If you would like a single room, there is an additional cost of **\$1,500.00** that will be added to the tour price. Single rooms are limited and will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none is available, you will be considered a "forced single," and charged one half (½) of the Single Room Supplement cost.

**Meal Plan:** Meal plans include two (2) meals a day, breakfast & dinner in Paris, and three (3) meals a day, breakfast, lunch & dinner in the Holy Land, with timing depending on the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on restaurant bills are included in the tour price for these meals. **A list of any and all dietary requests or food allergies must be emailed to [cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com](mailto:cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com) for hotel/airline accommodation at least seven (7) days before departure.** We cannot guarantee any dietary accommodations but will make all efforts to secure special dietary requests. In the event airlines or hotels are unable to accommodate dietary requests, you will be responsible for your meals; it is the individual's responsibility to choose appropriate foods while on the tour. Unused meals will NOT be reimbursed.

**Baggage:** Inspirational Tours, Inc. restricts all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage (max. 50 lbs.) and one (1) carry-on (max. 18 lbs.). **All passengers should check with the airline for up-to-date baggage weight/dimension information and restrictions, which are subject to change at any time before departure.**

**Airport Taxes and Fuel Surcharges:** are included in the tour price and are subject to change.

**The Tour Price Does Include:** Tips to guides, porters, headwaiters, and drivers.

**The Tour Price Does Not Include:** Expenses related to issuance/renewal of passports, laundry, mineral waters, wine & liquor, after-lunch/dinner tea, coffee, or food not included in the meal plan above; additional baggage; expenses of carriages, guides, sightseeing or other services other than those specifically mentioned as included in the itinerary; insurance for baggage or personal trip or health insurance; all items of a personal nature, in addition to those not listed above as being included in the tour price.

**Booking Conditions: Deposits and Payment:** **A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person**, payable via cash, check or money order, is required at the time of registration. No registration will be processed without a deposit. Invoices for final balances are issued at or near 90 days before departure. Full and final payment is due 60 days before departure. Registrations received within 90 days of departure require payment in full. If there is any outstanding balance by the Final Payment due date listed on your invoice, all travel services will be subject to automatic cancellation and cancellation fees will apply. A service reinstatement fee may be added to your invoice and must be paid in advance in order to apply for reconfirmation of services. **WE ONLY ACCEPT CASH, CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS FOR THE REGISTRATION FEE.** Payment by credit card is accepted ONLY for final balances or payments towards final balances; all credit card payments will be assessed a **3% non-refundable** convenience fee, which will be added to the total amount being charged.

**Cancellations and Refund Policy:** All cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR U.S. MAIL**. The date of the cancellation request is the date used for purposes of any assessed cancellation fees. Please note that some Registration Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE as stated on the Registration Form. Cancellation fees (as to any monies paid over the deposit for a tour with a non-refundable deposit) depend on the timing of the cancellation request, and are as follows: request received between time of registration and up to 59 to 45 days prior to departure—cancellation fee of **50%** of tour cost; request received 44 days or less prior to departure through date of departure—assessed **100%** of the tour cost (air and land, and any deviation fees) as the cancellation fee. Additional charges/fees for deviations and/or upgraded seats may require full payment at time of booking/confirmation, and may be non-refundable; **if a non-refundable air ticket has been issued prior to receiving notice of a cancellation request, you will be 100% responsible for those fees, in addition to the cancellation penalties listed above.** Package cancellation fees include airfare. Once airfare is purchased, either at time of booking, including but not limited to, deviations or seat upgrade requests, or at time of full payment, airline tickets will be issued and are always subject to a 100% penalty. Once full payment is received, Inspirational Tours, Inc. will issue airline tickets, which are non-refundable. Any additional fees required to be paid by the airline for deviation requests and/or seat upgrade requests will need to be approved by the passenger in writing before confirmed/reserved, and

if the request requires payment at the time of confirmation, this must be paid by the passenger at the time requested, and may be non-refundable. **ALL deviation or seat upgrade requests must be made in writing, at least 90 days prior to your departure date.**

**Tour Prices:** All tour prices quoted for transportation and land arrangements in this tour are based on rates, (including foreign exchange rates), in effect at the time of the original tour agreement with your tour host and Inspirational Tours, Inc. and are subject to increase without notice prior to departure. **NOTE:** Our tours are based on a minimum number of participants. We reserve the right to cancel or reschedule any tour for any reason including insufficient participants, or events beyond our control. Any cancellation will be advised at the soonest date possible. If ANY information provided (name, date of birth, etc.) does not match what is on your passport, you may be subject to penalties or fees for corrections to airline tickets, and/or may be denied boarding by the airline. Any name change, including minor spelling corrections, may require reservations to be canceled and re-booked. Reservations will then be subject to availability and pricing at the time of re-booking; any increase in airfare will be borne by the passenger.
